A minimum number of spare parts and components that should be available on-site in the event of a failure to minimize downtime.

Wearing Parts Kit

Wearing parts that should be available on site for service and maintenance to ensure the necessary replacement of parts as part of the on-site service.

Advanced Spare Parts Kit

A minimum number of spare parts and functional components that should be available on-site in the event of a fault, because delivery times are relatively high due to local conditions (e.g. onboard).
